On the Edge of discovery or despair? On the threshold of a new idea, a new material, or a new understanding?

On the Edge brings together six doctoral research artists whose practices span video, sculpture, painting and digital media. Presented at BOTH Gallery, the exhibition features new work by, **Rob Elford, Karolina Gliniewicz, Simon Mercer, Louise Richards, Jane Thurley** and **Rupert Whale**

The exhibition reflects a shared commitment to artistic research as a process of enquiry. Doctoral practice often occupies a place of uncertainty, where experimentation, failure, persistence and discovery are inseparable. It is here, on this shifting edge, that new ways of thinking and making emerge.

The artists' practices explore a wide range of concerns; from ageing, mortality and feminism; to pathways, the intersections between art and play, and our relationships with landscape, and establishing a sense of belonging or home. Through moving image, sculpture, painting and digital media, each artist investigates questions that are deeply personal while resonating with broader social and cultural conversations.
